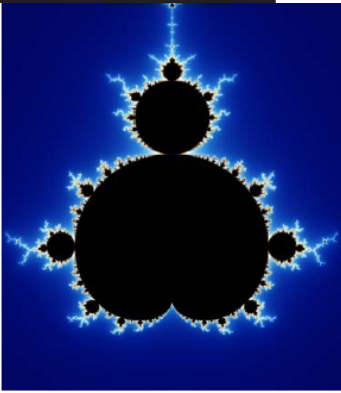

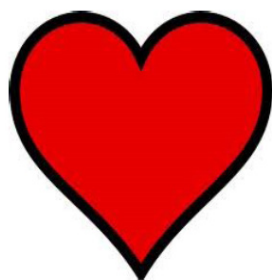
Top 5 resume tips:
